



The Isaac and Tamara Deutscher Memorial Prize honours two outstanding independent socialist writers and thinkers. Isaac Deutscher (1907-67) is best remembered for his classic biographies of Trotsky and Stalin. But he and his partner Tamara Deutscher (1913-90), a prolific author in her own right, also wrote extensive political commentary on world affairs, in particularly tracing the course of the Soviet Union from a critical Marxist perspective.

2007 marks the centenary of Isaac Deutscher's birth. Every year the Isaac and Tamara Deutscher Memorial Prize is awarded to a book exemplifying the best and most innovative writing in or about the Marxist tradition.

Past recipients include Istvan Meszaros, Marcel Liebman, Rudolf Bahro, G.A. Cohen, Geoffrey de Ste Croix, Barbara Taylor, Robert Brenner, Ellen Wood, Boris Kagarlitsky, Terry Eagleton, Arno Mayer, Mike Davis, Justin Rosenberg, Eric Hobsbawm, and Robin Blackburn. The annual Deutscher Memorial Lecture is delivered by the previous year's winner.
